


Preface

A. Purpose of this fascicle

Our goal is to produce a computerized database which will include information about photographs, documents and museum plates of the Dead Sea Scrolls. A computerized database will allow scholars to conduct different searches according to their particular research needs.

It is our intention to make the information in the lists available to scholars as quickly as possible. Since it will take some time before the computerized database will be complete, we have decided to compose preliminary lists about each of the particular collections (so far Cave 1, the Minor Caves and Murabbaat) and make these lists available to interested people in photocopy form. We wish to emphasize that these lists are still preliminary. The final database will include more information.

Much care has been taken to ensure that the information in these lists is accurate, but inevitably errors enter such a work. We would be appreciative if you would contact us about errors you find or additional information about the Minor Cave photographs at the Ancient Biblical Manuscript Center, Box 670, Claremont, CA 91711. B. Assistance for Work

The production of these lists has involved the skills of many people. Over the years some preliminary and partial lists were produced by the original editors and by museum officials. The most comprehensive lists before I began my work were prepared by Elisha Qimron in 1981. Further updates were added in 1985 to these lists by Qimron and John Strugnell. All of these lists were made available to me by John Strugnell when I began updating the materials. I wish to acknowledge their contribution without which my work would have been far more difficult.

A Dorot Fellowship made it possible for me to spend a year in Jerusalem working on revising and updating these lists. The Ancient Biblical Manuscript Center has provided me funding for my work at the Center this year. From March to July 1989 and from August 1990 to the present I have been working with the photographs at the Ancient Biblical Manuscript Center and from August 1989 through July 1990 I worked with the fragments and photographs at the Rockefeller Museum.

The Israel Antiquities Authority staff at the Rockefeller Museum helped me find appropriate fragmentary and photographic materials at the museum. Joe Zias, curator, gave me access to the materials. Ruth Peled, Marcia Sharabani and Donald Ariel also provided assistance. Ayala Sussmann and later Ronny Reich allowed me access to the photographs adjacent to their offices. Magen Broshi,

Curator of the Shrine of the Book, aided us in finding particular plates that had been moved to the Shrine of the Book for storage or conservation. The members of the Advisory Committee, composed of Amir Drori, Ayala Sussmann, Jonas Greenfield, Magen Broshi and Shemaryahu Talmon, have provided editorial assistance in the overall preparation of these lists.

The staff of the Ancient Biblical Manuscript Center helped me obtain access to the materials, provided administrative help, guidance and advice. James A. Sanders, president, has provided overall direction for the project. Former directors, Peter Pettit and Steve Delamarter, as well as the current acting director, Bruce Zuckerman, and Marilyn Lundberg, associate director, have provided much support.

Editors of the materials have provided a great deal of information. John Strugnell, international editor in chief while I was in Jerusalem, provided help in updating these lists and answering various questions that I had that arose while working on them.

John C. Trever made his photographs available for inventory purposes and provided guidance. James Charlesworth shared with me lists concerning 1Q materials and questions that had been prepared by Loren Stuckenbruck and Mark Harding. Robert Hall provided valuable assistance in making an inventory of the 1Q photographs at the Manuscript Center. Eunice Banda, secretary at the ABMC, provided word processing assistance.

Every item of the lists here has been checked and verified by us at the Ancient Biblical Manuscript Center or in Jerusalem at the Rockefeller Museum. There are reportedly other photographic collections of some 1Q materials but since these have not been personally examined they are not included here.

I. Introduction

The history of the discoveries and purchases of Cave 1 fragments and scrolls has been discussed in many works (See J. Trever, The Dead Sea Scrolls: A Personal Account, Revised Edition, Grand Rapids: Eerdmans, 1979; F. M. Cross, Jr., The Ancient Library of Qumran, Garden City, New York: Doubleday, 1961). Little attention has been given to the present locations of the fragments, scrolls and photographs of the same. The purpose of this publication concerning the 1Q fragments, scrolls and photographs is to help scholars find these materials so they can study them. More work still needs to be done on this data, but it seems best to make this work available to scholars now while it continues to be revised.

Information concerning the 1Q documents is arranged in three lists in this fascicle: documents, photographs and museum plates. In the document list the documents are listed sequentially according to their designated numbers in DJD 1. Included in this list are the photographs which pertain to each document as well as the present location of the fragments. In the photograph list the photographs which pertain to 1Q documents are given according to the inventory numbers assigned in each photographic collection. The museum plate list includes a list of the museum plates which contain 1Q materials.

The document list is cross referenced to the other two lists. It is expected that scholars would first refer to this list and then if they want further information about the photographs or museum plates they can refer to the other two lists. There is some duplication of information in the three lists but because there is often no one-to-one correspondence among documents, photographs and museum plates all three are necessary to provide all of the information that scholars may need in their research.

The seven major scrolls were found and sold by the Bedouin. The rest of the fragments which were later published in the first volume of the Discoveries in the Judaean Desert (DJD) series were collected in various ways. Some were bought from Bedouin, some were found in excavations by scholars and some were found by scholars sifting through the dump of earlier Bedouin excavations. Unfortunately no records are available that indicate from where each fragment came. Lankester Harding indicates that a "few pieces of inscribed leather, including the first piece we had seen in the Phoenician script," was found in the dump (DJD 1, p. 6). He also indicated that "Several hundred fragments of inscribed leather and a few fragments of papyrus were recovered, varying in size from pieces bearing one letter, or even half a letter, to a piece containing several lines of text in a column" (DJD 1, p. 7).

The description of fragments discovered is more complete in one of Harding's earlier publications (G.

Lankester Harding, "The Dead Sea Scrolls," PEQ 1949, pp. 112-116 + pls. XVII-XXI). Here he suggests that pieces from the following documents were found: pesher Habakkuk (no fragments of this MS were published in DJD 1, perhaps another pesher was meant), Hodayot, the War Scroll, Leviticus, Genesis, Judges and other non-Biblical books. The photograph of 1Q22 published in this early work is the same one as in LH 1393. The photograph of fragment 13 of 1Q5 Deut^b also corresponds to LH 1470-1472. Harding notes that some fragments of Deuteronomy were "acquired from an outside source" (p. 113). The set of Harding's field photographs probably were of fragments found during excavations but it is difficult to know for certain. It cannot be determined which fragments were found by scholars and which were bought from Bedouin.

Cave 1 fragments and scrolls are now located in various locations around the world. The seven large scrolls are housed at the Shrine of the Book (See Moshe Pearlman, The Dead Sea Scrolls in the Shrine of the Book, Jerusalem: Israel Museum 1988 for the story of their acquisition). Eleven museum plates of 1Q fragments are located in the Archaeological Museum in Amman, Jordan. There are about eight plates of Cave 1 fragments at the Bibliothèque Nationale in Paris. 1Q19^{bis}, 1Q34^{bis}, 1Q70^{bis}, 1Q71 and 1Q72 still remain with Athanasius Samuel in Lodi, New Jersey according to John C. Trever (Trever told me that Samuel had recently told him that at least some of these fragments were still in the possession of Samuel).

A distribution list of the manuscript fragments published in DJD 1 is given on p. xi of DJD 1. This list is not completely accurate, however, based on my examination of fragments at the Rockefeller Museum and the photos taken of the Amman collection by the West Semitic Research Project. 1Q10-1Q12 were not found at the Rockefeller Museum. 1Q17, 1Q18, two fragments of 1Q19, 1Q20 and 1Q28a are located in Amman Jordan and not at the Rockefeller.

There are a number of different photographic collections of 1Q materials. The PAM collection at the Rockefeller Museum contains most of the 1Q materials published in DJD 1. Rarely do these photographs correspond closely with the published photographs. Either old photographs were cut up and rearranged for DJD 1 or photographs used for DJD 1 are no longer available.

The IAA collection, also at the Rockefeller Museum, contains unpublished photographs of 1QHodayot taken at Hartmut Stegemann's request.

The Shrine of the Book collection contains photographs of the three scrolls published in Sukenik's volume.

The West Semitic Research Project possesses photographs of the Amman material as well as of the Genesis Apocryphon. Typically these include black and white, color, and infrared sets of both the recto and verso sides of photographed materials.

The John C. Trever collection contains his photographs of the three scrolls published in The Dead Sea Scrolls of St. Mark's Monastery. In addition, his photographs of 1Q34bis, 1Q19bis, 1Q70bis, and 1Q71-72 not in DJD 1 are in his possession. He also has a set of Lankester Harding's field photographs as well as other miscellaneous photographs. Trever generally has both color and black and white photographs of the materials he has photographed.

II. Documents

The document list is largely based on the numbering of documents found in DJD 1. Several of the larger scrolls have been assigned numbers in this list when more fragments were excavated or bought separately from the scrolls. Thus Isa^b is 1Q8, the Genesis Apocryphon is 1Q20, Serek Hayyahad is 1Q28, Hodayot is 1Q35, the War Scroll is 1Q33. Isa^a and pesher Habakkuk did not receive numbers. It does not seem advisable to integrate the separate publications of DJD 1, the Genesis apocryphon, the Trever volume and the Sukenik volume. One problem would be that fragments are numbered sequentially in each volume. Thus one has fragments 1-7 of Isa^b in DJD 1 and fragments 1-13 in Sukenik's publication of Isa^b.

B. Lankester Harding Field Photographs

These are copies which were given to John Trever. There are eight negatives in this collection, each of which generally has four photographs on it. Most of these photographs are numbered. In a few cases a number is used more than once for different photographs. Letters have been assigned to differentiate these such as 1407A, 1407B, and 1407C. Otherwise the numbers on the photos are used. Two photographs do not have numbers but are designated by Trever as being from the same collection. These are numbered 1497, 1498. Some of these photographs may have been rephotographed in the PAM series (note 40.436-40.447 which is a numbered series) but they do not correspond closely with this set. Possibly both groups belonged to a larger set of photographs taken by Lankester Harding.
